Sub: Minimum Wages Act, 1948 – Revision of variable Dearness Allowance to the Workers employed in various establishments with effect from 01-10-2023 & Minimum Wages Rates thereof – Reg.

Dear Sir,

I am to inform that the Chief Labour Commissioner (Central), New Delhi has revised the rates of variable Dearness Allowance as per consumer price index in respect of the following Scheduled Employment with effect from **01-10-2023** which are given below for your information.

The workers employed on minimum guaranteed time rate of wages per day would be entitled to time rate of Minimum Wages plus special allowance, if any, for unskilled category of above ground workers revised from time to time by the Central Government in respect of Scheduled Employment in Stone Mines.
- Per 2.831 cubic meters (100 cubic feet)
- ** Per truck of 5.662 cubic meters (200 cubic feet)

The V.D.A. has been rounded off to the next higher rupee as per the decision of the Minimum Wages Advisory Board.

The classification of workers under different categories and the classification of cities under different area will be same as in the notification referred above as amended from time to time. The present classification of cities into areas A, B & C is enclosed at annexure-1 for ready reference.

Explanation for the purpose of this Notification

Refer to S.O. Nos. 186(E), 188(E), 190(E), 191(E) dated 19th January, 2017 and S.O.2413(E) dated 28th July, 2017 New Delhi published in the Gazette of India; Extraordinary, Part-II; Section 3-Sub section (ii),

- Where in any area the minimum rates wages fixed by this notification are lower than
 the minimum rates of wages fixed by the State Government for employees in
 employment in aforesaid Employments in relation to which the State Government is the
 appropriate Government, the rates of wages fixed by the State Government shall in
 respect of these areas, be deemed to be the minimum rates of wages payable under this
 notification.
- The minimum rates of wages fixed by this notification are applicable to employees engaged by contractors also.
- The Minimum rates of wages payable to disabled employees shall be the same as payable to workers of the appropriate category.
- Men and Women employees shall get the same rates of wages for the same work or work of similar nature.
- Minimum rates of wages and special allowance both constitute the minimum rates of wages to be enforceable under the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (11 of 1948).

You are requested to implement the above Minimum Wages effective from 1ST October, 2023 in your organization and also bring it to the notice of all your Employers / Contractors and your subordinate establishments. Further, you are also requested to make necessary amendment in the Notice Board so displayed including the Revised Variable Dearness Allowance in addition to the Minimum Rates of Wages already notified and in force.
